Family Corner: "Kids Respect Fair Rules."

Children have a great sense of fairness that helps with discipline. When they know a rule is fair, they're more likely to obey it. The world is a confusing place, and kids actually want fair rules that steer them in the right direction. Here are some tips for making fair rules:

Collaborate. Talk about family rules with your children. Consider their opinions. But then you should decide what the rules should be.

Be specific. Make sure your child knows exactly what you want her to do. For example, "Make your bed and put away your toys," is better than, "Clean your room."

Give explanations. Talk about why each rule is important. This helps your child remember why she should obey.

Be reasonable. Rules should match your child's age and abilities. Change the rules as your child becomes older and more responsible.

Don't go overboard. If you make too many rules, they'll be impossible to remember and enforce.

Tip: Occasionally, use an "agreement" instead of a "rule" to help kids cooperate. For example, at a family meeting, ask each person to agree to do certain chores. Agreeing can motivate kids more than being told to do something.
